Dear Deputy Chief Shean,

I am writing to formally notify you of the corrective action being taken by MRRA in response to the Notice of Violation for Hangar 5 & Hangar 6 and the additional actions that have been taken to find a long-term solution to fire suppression that would allow for the removal of AFFF in all our hangars.

MRRA has engaged with Eastern Fire to fix the issues found in our fire monitoring systems. Once all repairs are made, we will conduct an annual test as required for Hangars 5 & 6. Per your conversation with Eric Perkins, MRRA Property Manager, October 30, 2024, is the projected completion date. Should that change for any reason we will be in contact with your office.

Additionally, MRRA has connected with Poole Fire Protection who will be conducting a risk assessment for hangars 4, 5, and 6 to determine alternative options for fire suppression. We have also had three companies look at our hangars and two will be providing quotes for an alternative foam fire suppression system and one quote will be for a new, non-foam fire suppression system that includes the use of an innovative floor system in conjunction with a water sprinkler system. We anticipate having these quotes back to us in the next two to three weeks.
