

TOURNAMENT DETAILS

The tournaments will be single elimination plus a consolation game, unless a team receives a first-round bye. These tournaments are not intended for Regional AAU type teams but instead are intended for teams that meet the following criteria:

- ◆ Teams that participate in Parks and Recreation, YMCA, or Youth Basketball Association programs.
- ◆ Teams that gather individuals from a common town or school district.
- ◆ Teams that are organized as a school team or have participated as a school team in the current season. (*Eligibility is at the final discretion of the Brunswick Parks and Recreation Department. Contact us if you have a question regarding your team's eligibility.*)

Please see included roster form. The \$225 entry fee must be paid at time of registration. Payments can be processed via telephone with a credit card, or you may mail in the registration form with a check. Complete rosters may be sent in later.
