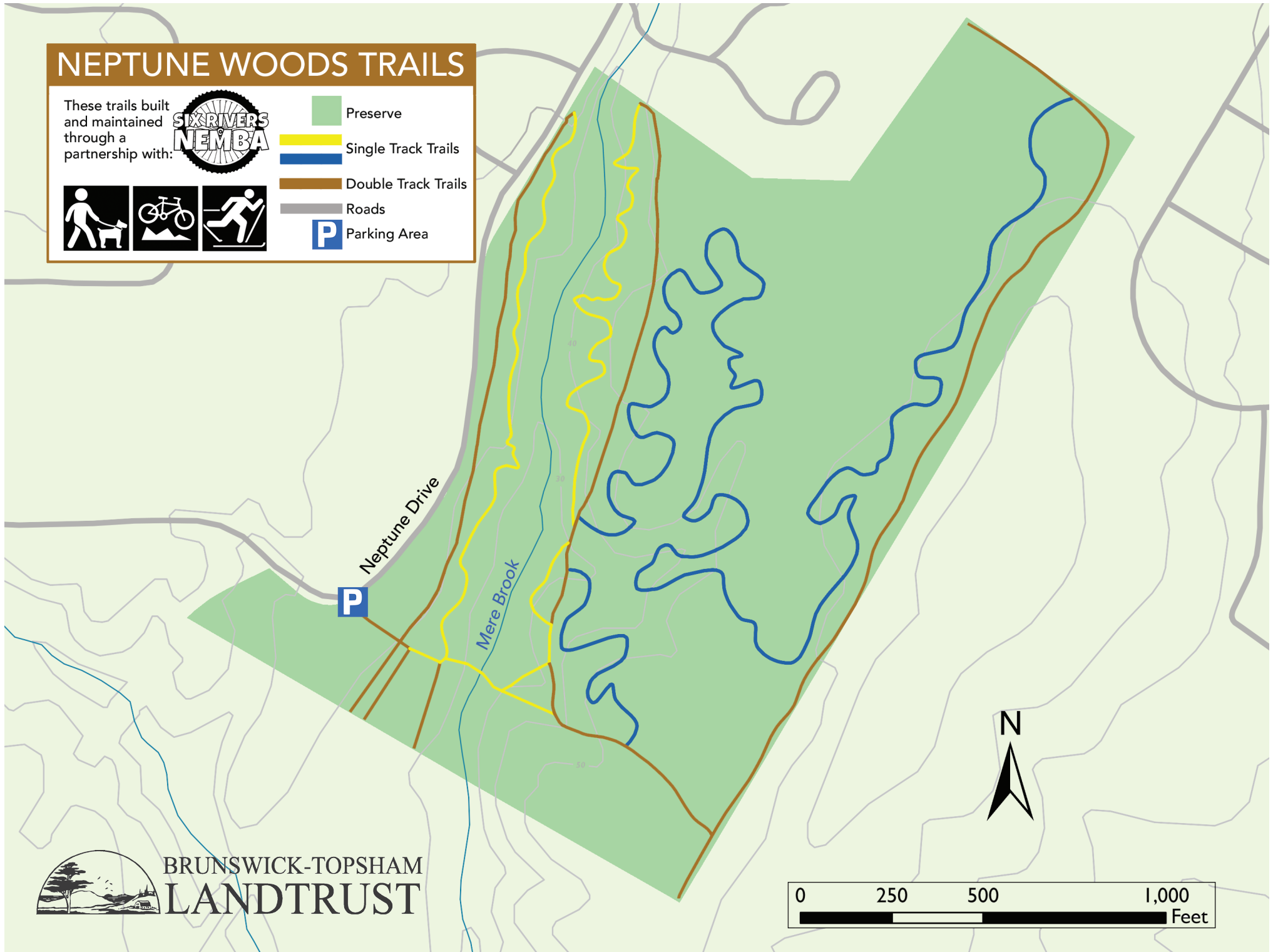

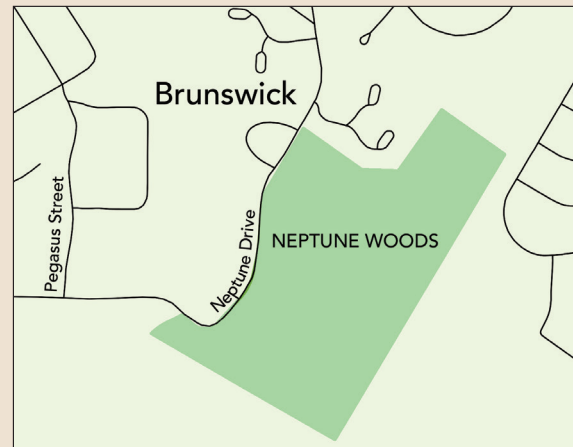

Neptune Woods

Neptune Woods is located at Brunswick Landing - land that was formerly part of the Brunswick Naval Air Station. The Air Station was decommissioned in 2011. Some land was given to the Town of Brunswick for conservation, but many other properties, though reserved for recreation, were not specifically conserved for that purpose. Neptune Woods is the first parcel on Brunswick Landing to be conserved and actively developed for recreation.

In 2017, local leaders of the mountain bike community reached out to BTLT to assist them in increasing the availability of mountain bike trails in the region. The 64-acre parcel located along Neptune Drive seemed like an appropriate location due to its proximity to the Brunswick Recreation Department, and because it was already home to a set of trails that had been used by the Navy. In 2018, Midcoast Regional Redevelopment Authority generously donated the land to BTLT. By that time the mountain bike community had organized into the Six Rivers chapter of the New England Mountain Bike Association. This group of volunteers created, built, and helps to maintain the trails at Neptune Woods. Please support and thank these valuable community groups!

These trails are open for mixed uses including mountain biking, hiking, running, snowshoeing, and skiing. Please yield to other trail users appropriately, and share respectfully – be nice, say hi!



DIRECTIONS TO PROPERTY

From the main entrance to Brunswick Landing (Rt 24/Cooks Corner), follow Admiral Fitch Ave approximately 0.8 mi., turn left on Forrestal Drive, and then an almost immediate right onto Neptune Drive. At the intersection with Anchor Drive, stay left on Neptune. At the south end of the Coastal Shores Property (on your right), the road makes a hard right turn and parking for the property is located to the left at this turn.

TRAIL USE RESTRICTIONS

- Open dawn to dusk
- No off-road vehicles or snowmobiles
- On-leash dogs permitted (dog waste removal required)
- No fires or camping
- Stay on marked trails
- No hunting or trapping
- Observe posted trail rules

Please be respectful of other trail users and the time it takes to maintain these trails:

- Do not ride bikes on trails if you are leaving a visible rut in the mud.
- In the winter - do not walk or snowshoe on ski track, do not bike or ski on groomed areas if you are sinking in more than one inch.
